## **ELIGIBILITY**

#### WHAT DETERMINES ELIGIBILITY?

- Students must be enrolled in a program that offers the WBL option.
- Students must have completed nine (9) semester hours credit (SHC) in their program of study, including three (3) hours in their core.
- Students must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or better on all work completed at Sampson Community College.
- Students must possess the basic skills required by the employer.
- Students must obtain approval from the Work Based Learning Instructor and work with their advisor to register for a WBL Course.

### **CREDITS**

Course credit is earned based upon the number of hours worked per week each semester

10-19 HOURS PER WEEK = 1 CREDIT 20+ HOURS PER WEEK = 2 CREDITS 30+ HOURS PER WEEK = 3 CREDITS
