DISABILITY SERVICES

Disability Services is dedicated to ensuring that students with disabilities or medical conditions have equal access to educational opportunities at Sampson Community College. By being a visible resource, it is our intent to provide appropriate services for the students, as they build upon their college success.

Under Section 504 (of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973) and the Americans with Disabilities Act, a person with a disability is someone:

- with a physical or mental impairment which substantially limits one or more major life activities.
- with a record of having such a disability; or is regarded as having such.

HOW TO RECEIVE ACCOMMODATION

1. Complete the [Self-Identification Form \(PDF\)](#), and provide up-to-date documentation of your disability or medical condition. Documentation must include a diagnostic report/assessment used to evaluate the condition and current treatment. It should also state the credentials of the diagnosing professional.
2. If you would like for the coordinator to request your medical records, please complete the [Authorization of Consent for Release of Medical Records Form \(PDF\)](#).
3. Submit all documentation to Coordinator of Special Populations & Testing, at disability@sampsoncc.edu or fax to our secure line at (910) 900-4399. The coordinator will reach out to you and schedule an appointment. Response time is usually 5-7 business days after forms and documentation are received. During high volume times, response may be longer.
4. Upon eligibility determination, students should make periodic contact with the Coordinator of Special Populations & Testing during the beginning of each term of enrollment and throughout the semester.
