The Emergency Medical Science Paramedic Bridging Track, is a degree completion track allowing certified non-degree Paramedics to achieve an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Emergency Medical Science. This program is comprised of major EMS courses along with related courses required in the curriculum. It includes required coursework offered online and some required work on campus.

The Emergency Medical Science curriculum provides individuals with the knowledge, skills, and attributes to provide advanced medical care as a paramedic for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical system and prepares graduates to enter the workforce.

Students will gain complex knowledge, competency, and experience while employing evidence based practice under medical oversight, and serve as a link from the scene into the healthcare system.

- Overall GPA 2.0 in college level coursework in related classes and core courses in the EMS program of study
- Must be currently certified as an active Paramedic in North Carolina
- Must have a valid state driver’s license
- Submit proof of EMS continuing education in the last two years. Copies of the following documents must be submitted with the program application:
 - State paramedic certification
 - EMS continuing education records during the current certification period
 - AHA Basic Life Support CPR certification
 - ACLS Provider certification
 - PALS or EPC Provider certification
 - PHTLS certification or equivalent
 - Other relevant EMS CE
