## **CNA II Licensure/Credentialing/Certification Information**

Certified Nursing Assistant II (CNA II) requirements vary by state and other individual factors; credentials, training, and job experience. It's important to note that not all states have reciprocity agreements or requirements. If you are moving to another state without a reciprocity agreement, you will have to retake the certification exam for that state. Student applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Requirements vary in each of the 50 states for the Certified Nursing Assistant program.
