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

Applicants who wish to enroll in the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) Online program at Sampson Community College must meet the following requirements:

Dates Awarded: Total Credits:

- Hold current unrestricted LPN license in North Carolina (or compact state).
- Current CPR (American Heart Association Basic Life Support Provider) Certification
- Applicants must show documentation of having worked a minimum of 2000 hours as an LPN in North Carolina or a state within the compact agreement in order to compete for a seat. Verification of such work will be required prior to beginning the program.
- Completion of all the ADN Support courses (earning a "C" or better) at a
 regionally accredited institution: BIO 168 4-credit hours, BIO 169 4-credit
 hours, ENG 111 3-credit hours, ENG 114 or ENG 112 3-credit hours, PSY 150 3credit hours, PSY 241 3-credit hours, Humanities elective 3-credit hours,
 and Math proficiency- MAT 003 (DMA 040 and DMA 050)
- Students applying to the LPN to ADN online option must achieve a score
 of 94% Probability of Passing NCLEX PN on the entrance exam. Please
 submit a copy of your passing exam with your application. Scores are
 acceptable for a period of three years.
- Students that have not had a computer class in the last 5 years will be required to take a computer assessment test with a passing score.
